## **Pronoun**

### **Definition:**

A word that is used in place of a noun is called a pronoun.

### **Examples:**

he, she, it, me, I, you, they, we etc.

He → Man, boy (male)

She → Woman, girl (female)

It → Animal, place, thing

I, me, my → Myself

### **Singular Pronouns**

he, my, she, you, it, I, me

### **Plural Pronouns**

we, they, you
