



# I, We, You, She, He, It, They

Read the following sentences.

1. Mohit likes to play. Mohit likes to play in the park.
2. Mohit likes to play. **He** likes to play in the park.

**He** is the word used in place of Mohit.

Some other words used in place of naming words are — **I, you, she, it, they** and **we**.

For male names, we use **he** and **his**. For female names, we use **she** and **her**. Words like **I, you, we, they** can be used for both male and female names. We use **it** for names of animals or objects.
