Pronouns

I, We, You, He, She, It, They

Read the following sentences.

1. Sana likes to dance. Sana likes to play the piano.
2. Sana likes to dance. **She** likes to play the piano.

In the above sentence, **She** is the word used in place of Sana.



Some other words used in place of naming words are **I, you, she, it, they** and **we**.

- For male names, we use **he** and **his**.
- For female names, we use **she** and **her**. Words like **I, you, we** and **they** can be used for both male and female names.
- We use **it** for names of animals or objects.

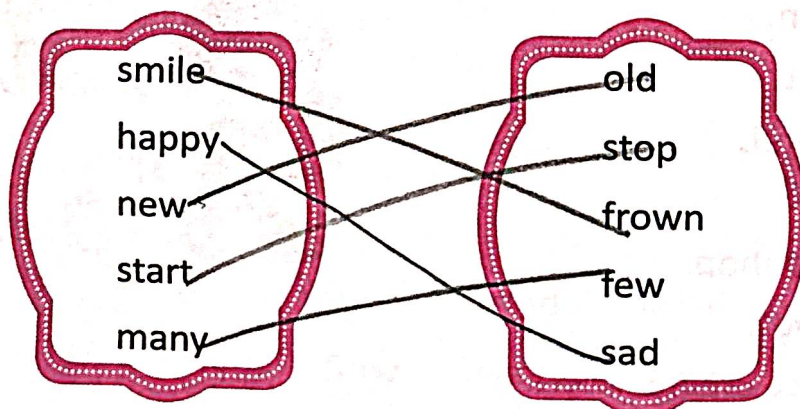

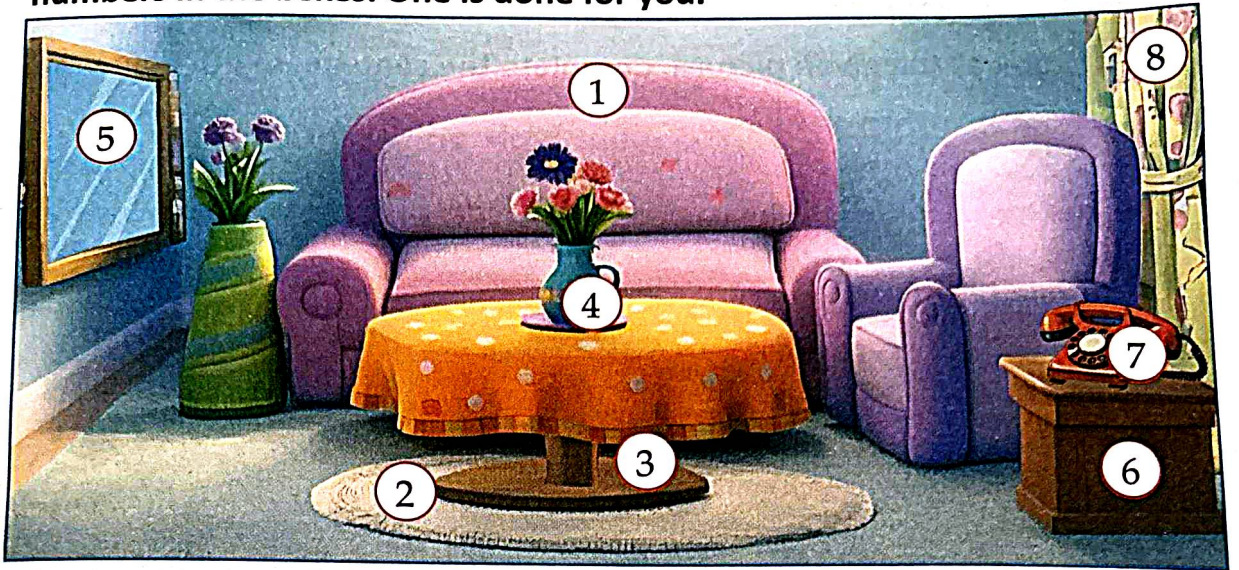
