Tense

Tenses are of the verb or action words that tell us the time of an action.

Tenses are of three main kinds:

1. Past tense — Yesterday
2. Present tense — today
3. Future tense — tomorrow

1. **Past tense** – An action that already took place.

eg. I played cricket.

2. **Present tense** – An action that is happening.

eg. I play cricket.

3. **Future tense** – An action that will happen later.

eg. I will play cricket.
