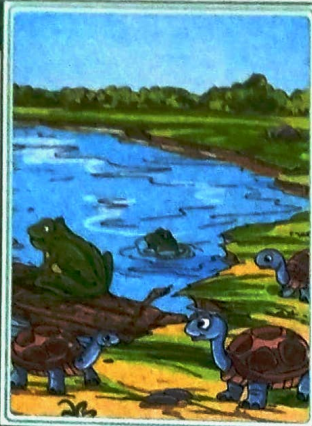

Ans. There are 64 biscuits in total in two packets.

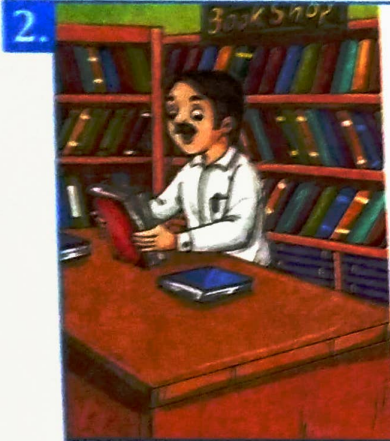

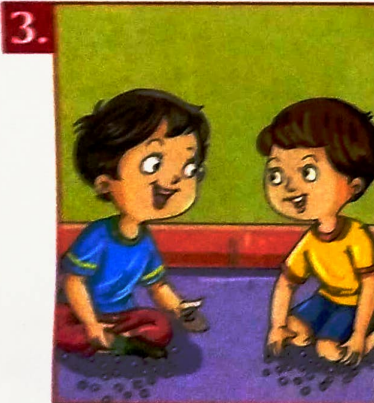
